The Zambia Medicines and Medical Supplies Agency (Administration of Fund) Regulations, 2023

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section 19 of the Zambia Medicines and Medical Supplies Agency Act, 2019, the following Regulations are made:

5. Subject to the approval of the Secretary to the Treasury, the Director-General shall establish an effective internal control system in accordance with the Public Finance Management Act, 2018.

6. The budget for the Fund shall be approved by the Board based on the information received from the public health facilities.

7. Subject to the Public Finance Management Act, 2018, the Secretary to the Treasury shall approve the bank accounts for the Fund.

8. Subject to the Public Finance Management Act, 2018, the Director-General shall ensure that the monthly bank reconciliations for the bank accounts for the Fund are done promptly.

9. (1) The Director-General shall prepare and submit to the Board quarterly financial records of the Fund.

(2) The financial records prepared under subregulation (1), shall include—

- (a) quantities and values of all medicines and medical supplies procured and issued;
- *(b)* quantities and values of all medicines and medical supplies distributed to the public health facilities;
- (c) quantities and values of medicines and medical supplies in stock;
- (d) quantities and values of expired or obsolete medicines and medical supplies; and
- (e) income statements, balance sheet and cash flow.
